



2023 CHRISTMAS PARADE

Line Up: 8:30am

All students, siblings, friends, and parents are invited to join CDA as we participate in the Concord Christmas Parade on Saturday, November 18th. Line up is at 8:30 am at the DMV parking lot on Hazen Drive. Please plan and arrive early, as there will be a lot of traffic as you get closer to the meeting place. We are located away from the other parade entries for safety reasons. The parade begins at 9:30 am. Saturday classes will be held as usual on this day.

We will be marching from Hazen Drive (up Loudon Road) to Canterbury Road, ending at the parking lot of the Community Bridges. We are unable to unload anyone from the vehicles along the parade route for safety reasons.

The float is reserved for the little ones (ages 7 and under) to ride on. All children on the float **MUST** be accompanied by an adult for supervision.

All students who march **MUST** be picked up in the parking lot at Community Bridges. We need a minimum of **four parent volunteers** to MARCH with our group and then wait with them at the parking lot for their pick-up. We appreciate all help in assisting with this part of the parade.

All students and adults riding on the float will have the option of riding the float back to Hazen Drive for pick up.

To present ourselves in an organized way, we are asking everyone to wear:

- Concord Dance Academy blue jacket if you have one. If not, any black CDA t-shirt over **warm clothing** will also be acceptable. We have CDA black t-shirts available in the office
- Red Santa hat
- Black pants (yoga pants, leggings, sweatpants, hip hop pants)
- Red stretchy gloves

(We believe Wal-Mart and the Dollar Store sell Santa hats, and gloves.)

Please note: The senior kick line will perform in front of the Judges Stand, located in front of Granite State Glass.
